Bean (short for Kidney Bean) is a 3-month old female tortoiseshell kitten who was found to have an abnormal kidney at the time of her spay/neuter surgery on the HSPCA's Fido Fixer surgical van. The kidney was surrounded by a large fluid filled cyst weighing just shy of a pound - and she was just 3.6 pounds! The kidney and cyst filled up her entire abdomen, and due to the abnormalities found and damage they were capable of causing to her other organs, the kidney and cyst were removed. Our vet cared so much, she personally took Bean home to ensure her recovery. Bean was a little off balance at first, but was on the mend in no time. We expect her to live a normal life. She is great with dogs, kids, adores other cats, and our vet has found her a furever home!

At our clinic, we offer many services such as spay/neuter surgeries, vaccinations, and microchipping for your pet at the lowest prices possible. Our mobile surgical van, Fido Fixer, travels to rural areas in South Carolina to offer services to benefit those outside of Columbia. Bean's story is just one of numerous occasions when our team has changed a pet's life. Because of our spay and neuter services, animals all over the state are saved from ending up in shelters, leading them to living happier and healthier lives.
