From moving into our new clinic to introducing a drive-thru system, we have thankfully been able to continue serving our community and provide low cost, high quality services. We are so grateful for all the clients and donors that made this possible, even with a global pandemic in the midst. So far in 2020, we were able to conduct over 8,400 surgeries and administer over 13,800 vaccines! We would like to take a moment to catch you up on what's been going on at the Humane Society these past few months.

INTRODUCING FERAL FRIDAYS

In October we introduced Feral Fridays; one Friday of each month we open our clinic to feral cats in Richland County. Thanks to the Animal Mission, we are able to offer services to these feral cats free of charge. We are so thrilled to have this opportunity to encourage our community to get involved in the effort to fight against animal overpopulation. Due to the coronavirus pandemic, the animal overpopulation rate is particularly outstanding this year. Feral Friday was our response to this issue to decrease the number of local ferals and ultimately the number of cats housed in overcrowded shelters. This year alone, we were able to spay/neuter over 450 feral cats in our community and with your help we will continue the fight against overpopulation throughout 2021.
