Cali is one of the many dogs whose lives have been touched by the Humane Society South Carolina. Earlier this year, we were alerted to a small dog that appeared to be neglected. After sending out our animal welfare officer, we learned more about Cali and her owners. Cali belonged to a single mother who's children adored Cali. They would play with her all the time and cuddle with her when they watched TV. Cali was deeply cherished, but unfortunately she was not receiving the necessary care she deserved. The owner, who was single-handedly caring for two young children and working long hours, had to prioritize their needs over Cali's medical care. As a result, her health needs were placed on hold. She was not up to date on her vaccinations, preventative medications or spayed. After meeting with Cali and her owners, our animal welfare officer knew something must be done. The Humane Society stepped in and ensured Cali was able to stay with her family. We provided necessities for Cali such as dog food, routine vaccinations and spay surgery to ensure she was properly taken care of and able to stay with her family that loves her so much.

Cali is just one dog we have been able to help thanks to donors like you. Because of you, Cali was able to receive the care she needed and stay with her family where she belongs.
